#### Introduction

KL reminded attendees that they should go into lunch early when it was a School Council meeting so we can start meetings promptly. Class teachers to be asked to remind representatives on meeting days.

# Topic for discussion

Our topics for discussion this week were green tokens and our characters and can we revamp or enhance them. The councillors took the topics to their classmates with the following outcomes:

**Year 3** felt the tokens should be bigger so adults could see them(!), though some felt smaller would be better. It was also suggested they were laminated. Year 3 also felt there should be further rewards for children achieving tokens and suggested a bronze award for five tokens, silver for ten and gold for twenty. Then once you had achieved a gold award you received a prize.

**Year 5** suggested Mr Work Hard and Captain Concentrate were too similar. They suggested different colours for each class as well as putting the name of the characters on the tokens. Year 5 felt the tokens should be harder to achieve. They felt prizes should be given for some achievements. They also suggested the class with the most tokens receive a reward as well as the child with the most. They felt there needed to be a criteria for achieving so people knew what they were aiming for.

**Year 1** said similar to Year 3 and 5. They suggested a new character all together. Year 1 also felt every character should be available each week instead of having one allocated for the week.

**Year 4** felt the token colours could be changed monthly though could not think of any benefits of this. They did suggest the tokens could be in house team colours. They also felt a gold token for the best of the best was a good idea.

**Year 6** suggested the class with the most awards could perhaps be rewarded with a treat, say an extra five minutes golden time or a trophy.
